In the fall of 2011 we will be adding the historic Amick/Watson Ranch to our hunting area. This beautiful 4500+ acre ranch that was originally homesteaded over 100 years ago by Ewin and Emma (Daum) Amick and their families encompasses much of the famous "L07" Mountain situated in the White River Valley.

Rising from 7000' at the lower end to nearly 8300' on top, this ranch is elk and mule deer country at its finest, with rolling sage brush flats, oak brush hillsides, large grassy meadows, aspen pockets, and abundant water sources. This place has everything! This ranch has historically been known for the large herds of elk and trophy mule deer that call the LO7 mountain home and also lies right in the middle of one of the largest big-game migration corridors in the country.

We are extremely excited about the opportunity to hunt this well managed property and are looking forward to the fall of 2011.

Hunts will be limited to very small groups, which translates to more personalized service and a memorable hunting experience.
